Advanced Internal Medicine: INPATIENT

OBJECTIVES:

The student will increase his/her knowledge of Internal Medicine.

The student will be given the opportunity to have direct responsibility for patients (under supervision).

The student will develop skills in the accurate assessment of medical problems and patient management.

DESCRIPTION:

The student will have the opportunity to participate in an intern-like role on one of the general medicine services. The student's responsibility will be similar to that of the first-year resident, except that orders must be countersigned by a senior resident. The student will work up patients, initiate their management, relate directly to admitting physicians and consultants, participate in rounds and conferences, and on some days take call with the senior resident until 6:00 p.m.

Inpatient: 100%.

EVALUATION:

Preceptor(s) will be asked to submit a written evaluation at the conclusion of the clerkship. Faculty are encouraged to provide ongoing feedback throughout elective rotations.
