**OBJECTIVES:**

- Become proficient in the comprehensive evaluation/physical exam skills for critically ill hospitalized patients.
- Be familiar with the interpretation of laboratory, procedural and diagnostic data as it relates to critically ill patients.

**DESCRIPTION:**

The student will attain competence at managing complicated general internal medicine patients in either the inpatient or outpatient setting. The student will attain the skills of an intern during this experience. Students function as an intern-equivalent on a critical care team with an attending physician. Students round daily with the physician and have the opportunity to perform procedures common to the critical care unit. Call is strongly suggested. Some evening and night shifts will most likely be required.

**EVALUATION:**

Preceptor(s) will be asked to submit a written evaluation at the conclusion of the clerkship. Faculty are encouraged to provide ongoing feedback throughout elective rotations.
