INSTITUTION:

DESCRIPTION:

Sub-internship. Assist in labor delivery and in the care of gynecology patients. Attendance at resident didactic session, gynecology rounds, patient pre-rounds. Participation in prenatal and postpartum clinics and in management of obstetrical and gynecological problems.

REQUIREMENT:

All Ob/Gyn electives require a paper or presentation on a topic agreed upon between the student and supervising physician. In addition, a separate evaluation sheet rating the paper/presentation is required.

EVALUATION:

Preceptor(s) will be asked to submit a written evaluation at the conclusion of the clerkship. Evaluation will be based upon clinical performance ratings from supervising physicians. Students may also be required to complete a patient logbook demonstrating varied/significant exposure to clinical experiences. Faculty are encouraged to provide ongoing feedback throughout elective rotations.
